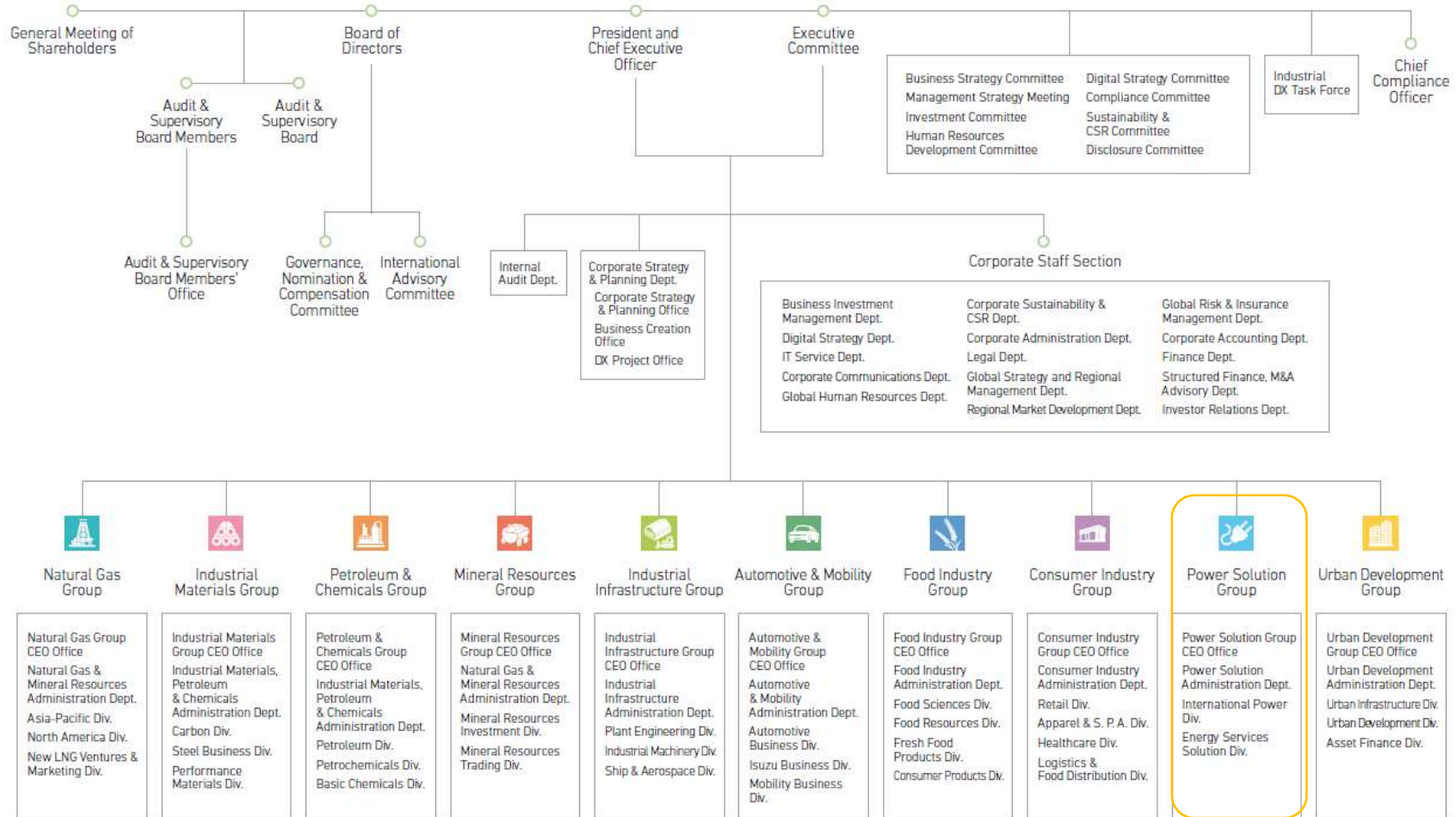

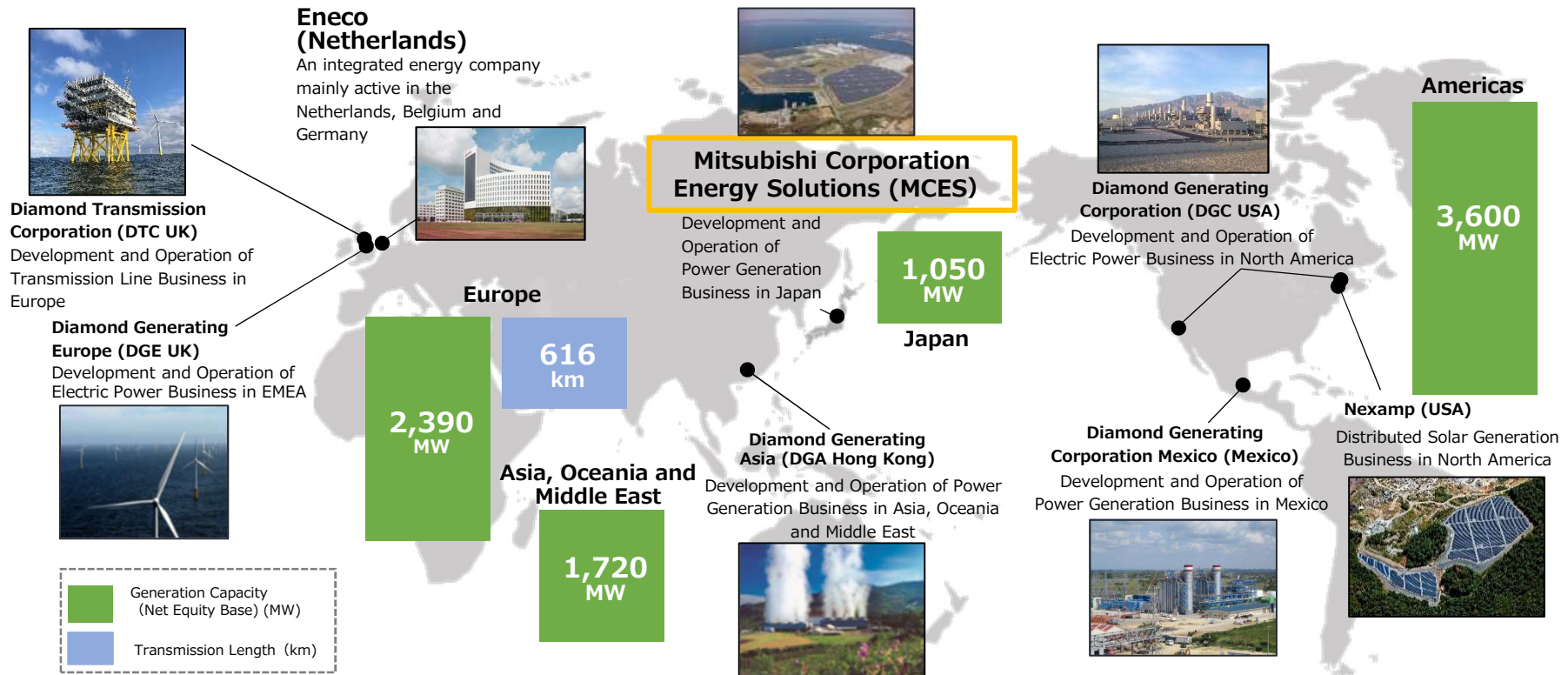
Organizational Structure

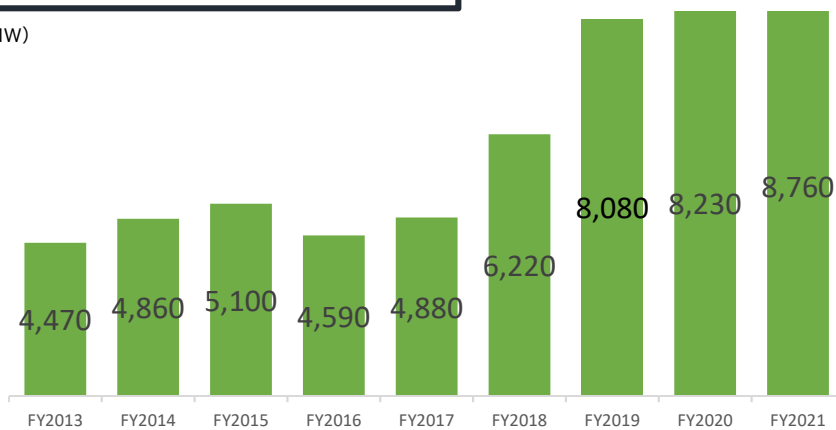
MC group Power Business Global Foot Print



Generation Capacity (Net Equity Base)

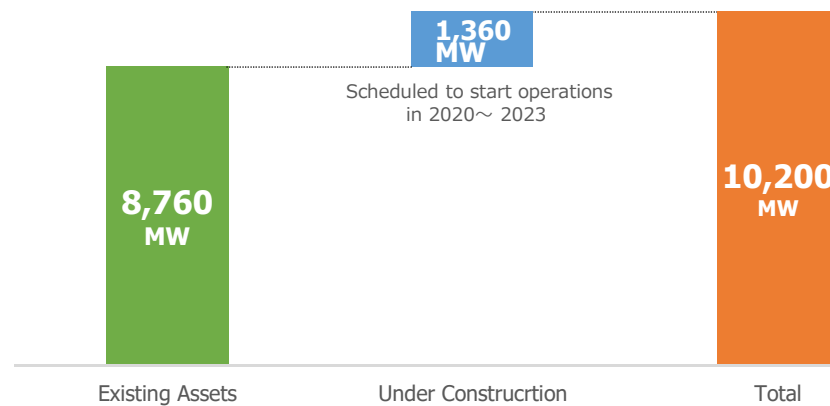

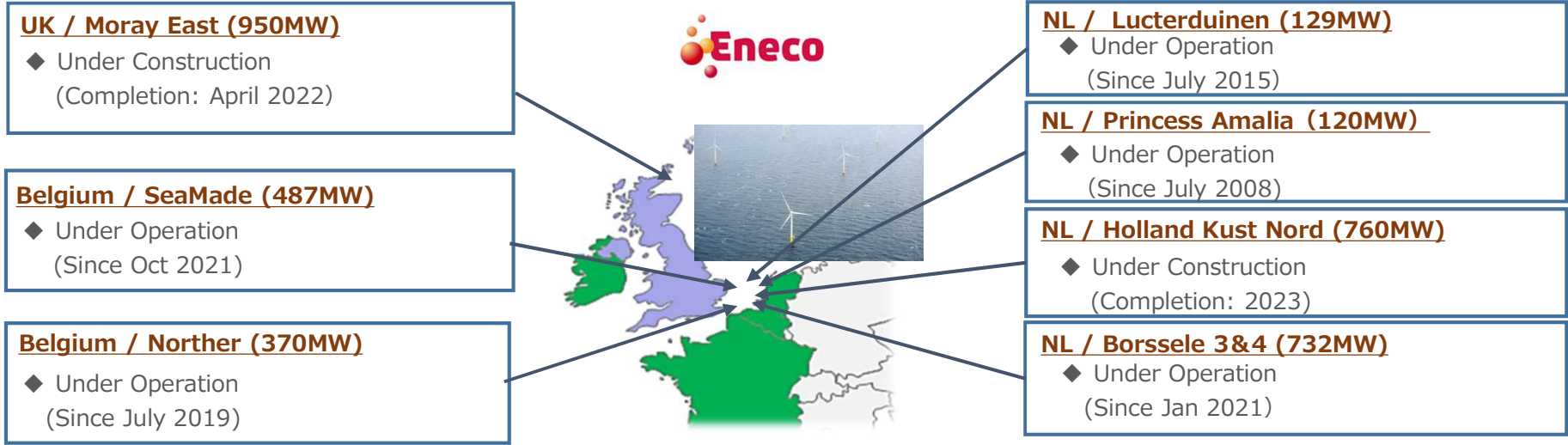
Generation Assets (Net Equity Base)

(as of March 31, 2021)



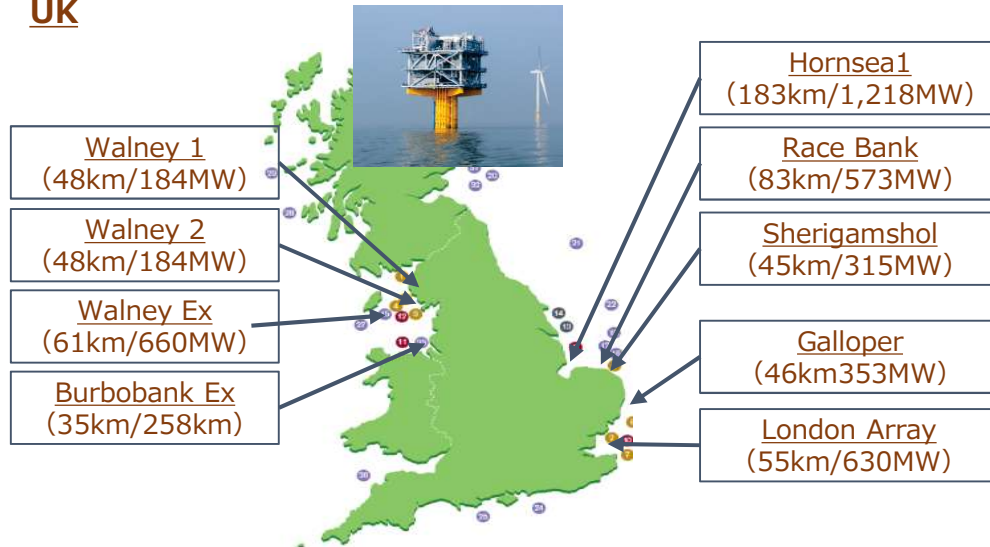
MC group Offshore Business Development Record in Europe

Offshore Wind (7 Projects / 3.5GW)

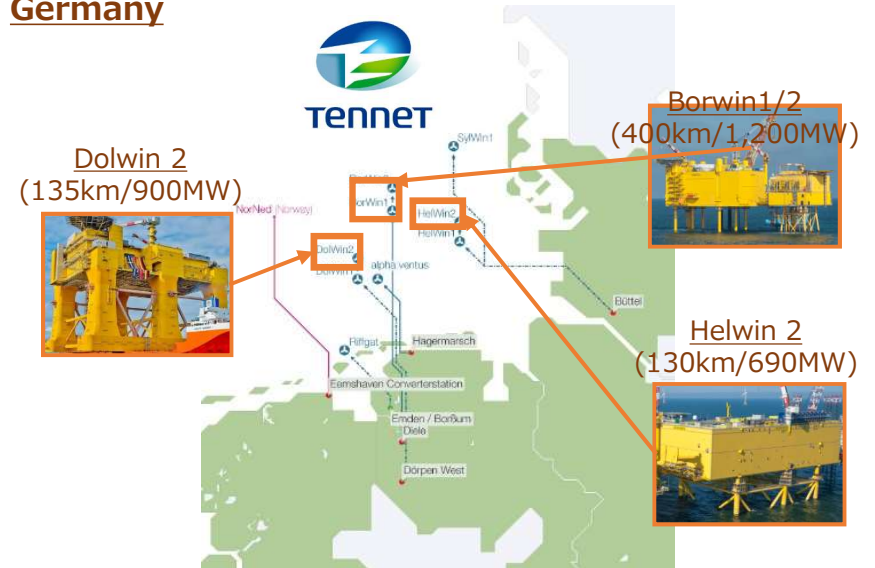


Offshore Transmission (13 Projects / 1,200km)

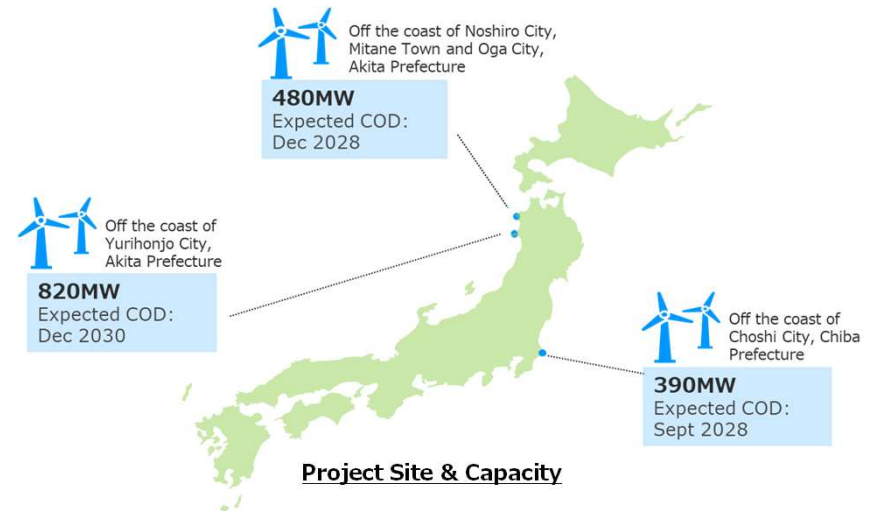

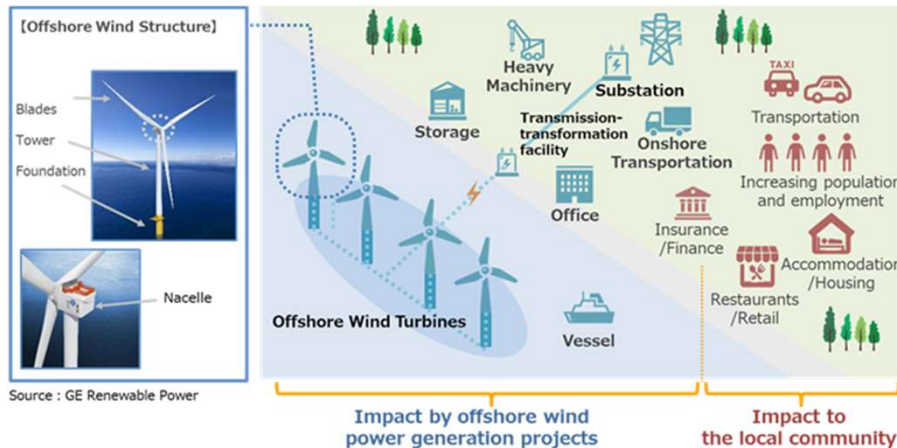
